Uranium Mine In Poland.

SOURCE ROME: Regular RFE Stringer from Polish sailors on board Polish ships arrived in GENOA.

DATE OF OBSERVATION: September 1953

ENGLISH SYNOPSIS: The uranium mine in RUDA near KLOCK is directed by Soviet engineers. The salaries of the mine workers are very high.

EVAL. COMMENT: This is a poor report. There are several localities bearing the name RUDA, but none in the area of KLODZKO (misspelled in the report as KLOCK.) It is known that the region of KLODZKO is relatively rich in uranium deposits and that there are some mines there, but RUDA had never been mentioned to date.
