URANIUM MINE

On Soviet request, the Polish glider flying school at  
KAZOW near JELENIA GORA was closed in the summer of 1951;  
courses are suspended because the Russians decided to run  
uranium mine in this area.

The mine is located at CHOJNASTY, an ancient castle ruin  
near JELENIA GOARA. The whole area round CHOJNASTY has  
been isolated, and "occupied" by MVD troops, whose camp  
is near a lake north-west of CHOJNASTY.

The prohibited area starts about three km from the rail-  
road and is surrounded by hedges. There were no villages  
in that area, so that "moves" were not necessary. Now  
this area is "populated" by Russians, both military and  
workers, who will run the mine.
