USSR -- BELORUSSIA ASKS DEFENSE MINISTRY TO SET UP MEDICAL UNITS

MUNICH, JULY 8 (CMD) -- THERE HAS BEEN A NEW CALL FROM THE SOVIET

REPUBLIC OF BELORUSSIA FOR HELP IN COPING WITH THE EFFECTS OF THE

1986 CHERNOBYL NUCLEAR ACCIDENT.

THE BELORUSSIAN SUPREME SOVIET HAS ASKED THE SOVIET DEFENSE MINISTRY TO SET UP MEDICAL SERVICE BATTALIONS TO HELP CARE FOR PEOPLE AFFECTED BY THE ACCIDENT.

IT HAS ALSO CALLED FOR THE DEFENSE MINISTRY TO EXEMPT FROM MILITARY SERVICE PEOPLE FROM BELORUSSIA WHO HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO INCREASED RADIOACTIVITY.

YESTERDAY THERE WAS A DEMONSTRATION IN MOSCOW BY PEOPLE DEMANDING MORE HELP IN DEALING WITH THE NUCLEAR CONTAMINATION.

BELORUSSIA SUFFERED SOME OF THE WORST CONTAMINATION FROM THE ACCIDENT AT THE CHERNOBYL NUCLEAR POWER PLANT IN THE UKRAINE, JUST SOUTH OF THE BELORUSSIAN BORDER.

ISLAMABAD, JULY 8, NCA/REUTER - CHINA HAS REOPENED ITS "SILK ROAD" TOURIST ROUTE INTO PAKISTAN AFTER A TWO MONTH DELAY. PAKISTANI TOURISM OFFICIALS SAID TODAY THAT CHINA OPENED THE ROUTE, WHICH CROSSES INTO PAKISTAN FROM CHINA'S XINJIANG REGION THROUGH THE 4,900-METRE KHUNJERAB PASS, ABOUT JULY 1. CHINESE OFFICIALS HAD SAID THE ROAD WOULD NOT REOPEN AS USUAL MAY 1 FOR THE TOURIST SEASON BECAUSE OF POOR ROAD CONDITIONS AND AVALANCHES.
