12. Occupation: After he was freed from prison, from May thru July, 1956, he was a janitor at a TB sanitorium, in Budapest. August thru October until revolution, he worked as an unskilled laborer in a sawmill in Budapest.
13. Parents living: Father 70 and mother 64. Both are in Budapest.
14. Sisters or brothers: Sister 37 in USA and another sister 27 in Argentina.
15. Date departed Hungary: November 20th, 1956
16. Arrived USA: December 15, 1956

17. Travels in USA: Poughkeepsie, New York for one month and Bard College for one and a half months, and about one month in New York City.
18. Immediate plans: Continue his studies and achieve his Ph. D.
