2. Man is 26 yrs. old.

6. Born in Nyiregyhaza, Hungary.
7. Spent most of his life in Nyiregyhaza.
8. Was in Nyiregyhaza just before the revolution.
9. Respondent was never abroad.
10. He was in service from November '52, to Nov. '55.
11. He is a high school graduate, that is a graduate of a school called a real Gynnasium and he had completed six semester of electronics engineering.
12. He worked as an electronic engineer in an amplifying station at the Hungarian post office network, because the post office operated all the telephones in Hungary. He worked there from March '51, until Nov. '52. After the military service, again from '55, until Nov. '56.
13. Bother parents are living; his father is 57; his mother, 52
14. They are at Nyiregyhaza.
15. He has a sister 24 years old, and who is in Kentucky studying at a college. She lived with him. He has a brother 20 years old, in Austria, but they are not sure whether or not he is alive, because they have not received any word from him for the last four months since they fled. He has another 17 years old in Nyiregyhaza, and a brother, 9 yrs. old also in Nyiregyhaza.
16. He left Hungary on Nov. 24th, 1956. Arrived in the US in Dec. 11, 1956.
