8. Respondent lived before revolution broke out in Budapest.
9. She was on a visit to Romania in the summer of 1956, and in Czechoslovakia in summer of 1954.
11. Education - high school graduate, and held a chemist's diploma from the Budapest University of Medical Sciences.
12. Respondent worked in different pharmacies after 1945 in Budapest, and ~~from 1945 to 1956~~ she worked in a state pharmacy at the corner of Rakocsi street and the Nagy ~~teret~~. From June 1956, until the outbreak of the revolution, she worked as a pharmacist in the Chinoin Pharmaceutical plant in Budapest.
- Respondent's husband was ⁴⁵ 33 years old; a physician and also a Baptist, ~~and he~~ remained in Hungary.
13. Her mother lives in Budapest. She is ⁴⁵ 45 yrs. old. She also has one brother, aged 30, who lives in Cleveland, O.
