7. Respondent spent most of his life in Sarosbatak (eight years) and lived in Budapest since 1940.
8. Respondent lived in Budapest when the revolution broke out.
9. Respondent was abroad several times; in 1936 in Czechoslovakia and Austria to make movies.
10. Respondent served eight weeks in the Hungarian Army in 1931 as a private.
11. Respondent's education: five years of elementary school; gymnasium diploma; three years in a theatrical academy; three years of law until 1949 when respondent was excluded from all Hungarian universities.
12. Respondent's occupation: movie producer, then movie writer; from 1945-46 he worked as an assistant in a movie studio; from 1946-48 he was in prison; from 1949-52 he worked as an assistant producer in a movie studio; from 1952-54 he worked as a reporter for a weekly newspaper; 1954-55 worked in the press division of a State enterprise; 1955-56 he worked in the vegetables department of a State enterprise and in 1956 he worked again as a movie producer.
