Speaking of his immediate plans, he says he would like to return to his family the minute a war or a revolution broke out, and he would like to fight with arms for his country and his family. -- When he is told that perhaps the realization of that plan is not an immediate one, he answers that he would like to work as a custodian, as he is working now.
20. He was interviewed only on one occasion by the Church World Service, and that lasted only for a few minutes. But he says that was an interview beyond the personal regular interviews.

9. Was abroad from Jan. 1942 to October 1943. He was a front soldier in Soviet Russia in the Hungarian army.
10. He served in the Hungarian army from 1938 to December 1944, and in 1943 he became a sergeant.
11. His education consists of five grades of elementary school.
12. Until the age of 23, he was a farm hand on large estates. From 1938 ~~xx~~ through 1944 he was a soldier, and from 1945 to 1948 he held odd jobs. Because he was not a member of the Communist Party, he could not get a really good job suitable for him, so he went from one place to the other. - From 1948 he worked as a plumber, working for the buildings of the Hungarian Red Cross until 1949. In 1949 he was transferred by the Manpower Commission to the Csépel Rakosi Works. Working for that plant, he was also a plumber, and a welder until March 1953. - From 1953 he worked for State Bridge Building Enterprise until the revolution.
13. His mother is still living. She is 68 years old and lives in Budapest.
14. He has two brothers. One is 49 years old and another one 47. He also has two sisters. One is 45, the other is 32. All of these are living in Budapest.
15. He has a boy 13 who lives with his wife in Budapest.
16. He left Hungary on November 15th.
17. He arrived in the U.S. on November 22nd.
18. He has lived in New York City on the east side of town in Yorkville.
