## PERSONAL INVENTORY

1. Respondent's Code No. is 61-M
2. Age - 17
3. Sex - Male
4. Marital Status - Single.
5. Religion - Catholic
6. Born in Budapest
7. Spent most of his life in six villages in Hajdu-Bihar County.
8. Just before the Revolution broke out he was living in Debrecen.
9. He was never abroad.
10. He never served in the Hungarian military service.
11. Education - Eight grades in Elementary School and one year in Vocational High School of Hotel and Restaurant Workers.
12. Respondent was a waiter. He became such three months before the Revolution.
13. Respondent was a foundling, hence nothing is known about his natural parents. He had no foster parents either, because he was given from one family to the other, a state orphanage looking out for him, and placing him with various families.
14. Since respondent was a foundling, and he has no idea of his parents and was not registered at all, he has no idea whether his parents had any other children, consequently whether he has any brothers or sisters. Also, since he did not become a foster child, he has no foster brothers or sisters either.
15. He is single, and naturally has no children.

16. He left Hungary on Nov. 22, 1956.
17. He arrived in the United States on May 25, 1957.
18. He has been in the United States only a few days, in Brooklyn.
