10. Respondent was in the Hungarian military services from 1935 to 1941. He was a draftee. In 1942 he was called in for two weeks of active duty during the Yugoslav campaign, and later again in 1944 he was on active duty from August until the Hungarian Nazis took over on October 15. He didn't want to serve under the Hungarian Nazi leader named Szalasi, and he refused to take oath under him, and when he was to answer charges he deserted the army and was in hiding until the end of the hostilities. The highest rank respondent attained in the Hungarian army was that of a private first class.
11. Respondent completed 4 years of grade school and 4 years of a secondary type school of the humblest kind, that is to say practically speaking, he completed 8 grades.
