#### I. CHARACTER DESCRIPTION

Noticeable is his extreme hatred of the Communists. He shows great excitement whenever the revolution comes in question, and can hardly give up the subject. The manner in which he approves of the extermination of AVH men might indicate some sadistic undercurrent. However, his fondness of flowers and his desire to become a doctor and help people counterbalances it and makes his personality controversial.
