I. CHARACTER DESCRIPTION:

This young girl comes from an easy-going theatrical background. Mother was a dancer who toured Europe before her marriage, and after the death of her husband she worked in the entertainment business (cafes, nightclubs, etc.). Subject is of Jewish origin, her father one-half Jew, mother ditto, and thus her father had been deported by the Nazis and never returned. Subject is a posthumous child.

She studied back in Hungary for the stage (dancing) and is doing the same here. Due to her background and "experience" she is more poised and sophisticated than most children this age (12 years) would be. She is very mature, serious, and ambitious child, who picked up English extremely quickly.
